2. Terms and conditions are provided on The Deaf Lottery’s Facebook page (www.facebook.com/thedeaflottery) and website (www.deaflottery.com.au) for the duration of the competition.
3. Terms and conditions will be referenced in all pertinent material relevant to the competition.
4. Entry is only open to Australian residents over 18 years of age who reside in Australia. Employees and their immediate families of the Promoter and its agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter.
